# PINOT NOIR

This blend shows a delicate shade of light burgundy and expresses a medium body framework, with a measure of balanced structure and clean fruit flavors. The nose is complex with red and blue fruit, and hints of fresh raspberry and purple violet notes. On the palate, this wine is packed with bright red fruit in the form of fresh cherry, raspberry, and plum nuanced with minerality fresh green and subtle toasty notes. This wine is elegant and the depth of flavors go on and on. With just the right amount of acidity, this true Sonoma Coast Piñot Noir is impressive now and will age with elegance.

## PINOT NOIR

Gazing at this dark ruby wine, you will be impressed immédiately. As you swirl, the red fruit bouquets of cranberry and raspberry are infused with a spicy earthiness and sweet aromas. The fresh coastal notes dance on the palate with high toned red fruit, hints of herbal freshness, tied together by a nice measure of toašty oak. The great level of natural acidity as well as the impressive structure will help this wine mature over time. Enjoy now or let it rest in your cellar.

## 2021 LERAS FAMILY VINEYARDS

#### PINOT NOIR

This wine begins with a beautiful garnet color and inviting clear red fruit aromas. As the wine opens, impressive notes of caramel, crushed rock and barrel toast are expressed. The palate will burst with juicy sweet red fruit of cherry and strawberry with hints of rhubarb and pomegranate lingering on the palate. The wine is very well balanced and extremely lush but still shows bright acidity on the finish. This wine is already showing great character and will continue to shine with a bit more age. This is a classic representation of the Russian River Valley.

## 2021 POMMARD CLONES

#### PINOT NOIR

The radiant dark red hue of this wine is truly impressive. The complex nose is driven by deep red and blue fruit flavors and toasty oak. The aromas will gain complexity as the wine opens. On the palate, you can't miss the blackberry, purple plum and earthy notes with generous caramel and toast flavors. This complex blend is enhanced by a balanced acidity and some fine grain tannins, making this wine extremely remarkable. Drinking noticeably well now and will gain depth with some age. Once you taste this unique clonal blend, you will agree it is extraordinary.

#### 2021 DRY CREEK VALLEY ZINFANDEL

This rich deep crimson wine combines the best fruit of Dry Creek Valley and is one of the few Zinfandels to use French Oak barrels. The nose bursts with intense notes of deep ripe red fruit opening with aromas of sweet plum and high-toned floral notes. The palate delivers intense sweet cherry, raspberry, and strawberry that mingle with mouthwatering acidity. As the wine opens with equal measures of blueberry and plum, supple tannins with a mild earthiness are expressed to enhance the long finish. This wine is powerful and voluminous, with the perfect balance of impressive flavors that will evolve over the years.

Settling in, Renae took up a waitressing role at Page One restaurant, conveniently nestled just behind the San Francisco Chronicle Newspaper building. Regular patrons of the restaurant included truck drivers for the Chronicle, this is how she met her late husband and Co-founder, Bruce Perry.

Renae moved on to build a successful career in software product management for many years, while Bruce and Ben began their initial hobby of crafting wine in their garages. In 2001, Renae and Bruce relocated to Healdsburg, where Renae officially joined the winery efforts by promoting and selling wine directly from their home.

## ROAST CHICKEN & CREAMY POLENTA WITH

## RED WINE BURST CHERRY TOMATO SAUCE

Chef Jim May has crafted an exquisite dish to pair perfectly with the 2021 Leras Family Vineyards Pinot Noir found in your Fall Wine Club Allocation. The robust yet nuanced flavors of the dish complement the notes found in this delicious wine, making it an exceptional pairing choice. The tender, herb-infused chicken thighs echo the wine's earthy undertones, while the burst cherry tomato sauce, enriched with the Pinot Noir, harmonizes with the wine's fruity complexity. The creamy polenta provides a comforting backdrop that elegantly balances the dish's flavors and textures.



# Ingredients (Serves 4 People)

## Chicken:

- •2 t. kosher salt
- •2 t. garlic salt
- •2 t. paprika
- •2 t. brown sugar
- •2 t. dried oregano •1 t. black pepper
- ·3 lbs. bone in, skin on chicken thighs
- •2 T. alive ail

## Polenta:

- •3 c. milk
- •3 c. water
- •1 T. kosher salt
- •1 t. black pepper
- •1 1/2 c. ground polenta

## Sauce:

- •1/3 c. olive oil
- •4 c. whole cherry tomatoes
- •1 T. kosher salt
- •1 t. black pepper
- •4 cloves of garlie, minced
- •1 c. Pinot Noir
- •1 t. dried red pepper flakes
- •1/4 c. thinly sliced fresh basil
- •2 T. butter
- •1/2 c. grated Parmesan cheese

## Directions

Preheat oven to 400°. Mix the 6 seasonings together. Dry the chicken thighs with a paper towel. Rub with olive oil and season both sides with spice mixture. Place on a foil lined baking sheet.

Bake for 30-40 minutes until browned and thermometer in the thickest part reads 160°. Remove and let it rest for 10 minutes.

While the chicken is cooking prepare the polenta and tomato sauce.

Combine 3 c. milk and 3 c. water in a large saucepan and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat and slowly add the ground polenta while stirring. Return to a low simmer and keep stirring and scraping the bottom for 30 minutes until creamy, adding more water if necessary.

Heat 1/3 c. oil in a large saucepan and add 4 c. whole cherry tomatoes, salt and pepper. Cook for 20-25 minutes over medium-low heat stirring often until tomatoes burst. Add garlic, red wine, and pepper flakes, stirring for another 10 minutes until a glossy sauce is formed. Stir in basil and butter and remove from heat. This sauce can be prepared in advance.

Spoon the polenta onto a plate, top with sauce, Parmesan cheese, and basil. Place chicken alongside or on top and finish with a drizzle of sauce. Serve with the 2021 Leras Family Vineyards Pinot Noir.

Blessed with rich valley soils, moderate winters, abundant sunshine, and the unique cooling fog from the nearby Russian River, the vineyards are perfectly situated to produce grapes of unmatched quality. The fluctuating temperatures allow our grapes to develop full flavor maturity while retaining a refreshing natural acidity, a hallmark of Papapietro Perry Pinot Noirs.

Pinot Noir, often referred to as the "heartbreak grape," demands special attention and care. Nick meticulously manages the Leras Family vines by selectively pulling leaves and thinning shoots on sun-exposed vines to ensure proper air circulation and movement. His vigilant approach safeguards against potential challenges like Botrytis, commonly known as "bunch rot", and Spring frosts that could harm the vines.

The Leras family's commitment to sustainable farming is at the core of their vineyard's philosophy. Their vines are dry-farmed and trellised using a modified Scott-Henry system, ensuring the perfect balance for the fertile soil, and resulting in wines with deep, layered flavors that captivate the senses. Nick's sustainability practices include planting cover crops, which are later tilled back into the soil and enriched with organic material. The cover crops also play a crucial role in reducing water runoff and preventing soil erosion. These practices along with many others have led to a much-earned title of Sustainable Farmer of the year at the 2022 Sonoma County Harvest Fair.

Next time you open a bottle of Leras Family Vineyards Pinot Noir, savor the rich heritage of over a century of grape growing at its finest. Cheers to Leras Family Vineyards, a true reflection of our passion, dedication, and love for the land.

## CELEBRATING OUR 25TH HARVEST:

To celebrate this wonderful milestone, we are delighted to release the Founder's Blend to our Wine Club. The history behind the Founder's Blend is significant when enjoying this exclusive bottling of 777 Clones and Pommard Clones, from both the Leras Family Vineyards and the Peters Vineyard. These vineyards have played a crucial role in our line-up and pay homage to the first Pinot Noir vineyards that we produced in 1999 and 2000. We consider them to be the "founding vineyards" of the winery. To our mutual benefit, we have been growing, learning, and making great wines for more than two decades and we wanted to acknowledge this important and extraordinary relationship.

The Peters Vineyard was our first vineyard designate in 1999 and we were the first winery to make high-quality Pinot Noir from the site. It is a prime location for balanced, fruit driven wines with well-drained Goldridge soils, foggy cool mornings, and bright sunny afternoons. The grapes continuously produce notes of juicy cherry and red fruits with great acidity. We rely heavily on Randy Peters' vineyard knowledge, and our partnership has benefited our wines year after year.

Leras Family Vineyards is a textbook Russian River Valley site. It too has rich soil with cool foggy mornings and the perfect terroir. We continue to marvel at how well the vineyard reflects each vintage with complex blends of red raspberry, rhubarb, and strawberry coupled with Russian River Valley cola and earthiness.



The process in making this wine is similar to our other Pinot Noirs; do as little as possible to guide the wine into the barrel. The real difference here was in the blending. It's one of our favorite parts of winemaking. We were excited that these two very different wines came together in such a beautiful way.

The taste profiles of the two vineyards are framed by warm caramel and soft oak notes from the Francois Frères barrels. This elegant wine is comprised of equal percentages of each Clone as each vineyard combines the finest elements to make a truly exclusive wine.
